

The president of the provincial court of Almeria is the representative of this judicial organ. The president is appointed by the General Council of the Judiciary, with a term of office of five years. The president combines governmental and representative tasks of the post with the presidency of a section of the court.

The president of the Provincial Court of Almeria is Magistrate Lourdes Molina Romero.

Born in 1959, Lourdes Molina Romero entered the judicial profession in 1987, the year she became magistrate in charge of the First Instance and Examining Court of Puente Genil (Cordoba). In 1989 she was assigned to the 4th First Instance and Examining Court of Jaen, where she remained as magistrate in charge until 1991, when she moved to the Provincial Court of Jaen.

After a professional career in Jaen, she was elected president of the Provincial Court of Almeria, a post she assumed on 20 November 2009.
