

The president of the provincial court of Jaen is the representative of this judicial organ. The president is appointed by the General Council of the Judiciary, with a term of office of five years. The president combines governmental and representative tasks of the post with the presidency of a section of the court.

The president of the Provincial Court of Jaen is Elena Arias-Salgado Robsy.

Born in 1956, Elena Arias-Salgado Robsy entered the judicial profession in 1980. One of her first postings was in the 1st First Instance and Examining Court of Cazorla. After a brief stint with the 32nd Examining Court of Madrid, she returned to Jaen in 1989 to take charge of the 2nd First Instance and Examining Court of Jaen.

In 1994 she began her career in the Provincial Court of Jaen. In 2009 she was appointed president of that court, becoming the first female president of a provincial court of Andalusia.
